CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: AS A FAMILY



This Sunday, between Christmas and New Year's Day has traditionally been celebrated as the Feast of the Holy Family. It is good that the Lord, our Savior, came among us as a member of a family. The Gospel

today concludes with the beautiful sentence, "He went down to Nazareth and was obedient to them." This is a good reminder that the values which help keep families together are the same values that help us live and work together and bring his love and message of salvation into the world.

During this time of the year, our Parish Staff and many of the ministries and organizations of the parish have been gathering as families, thanking God for what we



have been empowered by the Holy Spirit to do in God's name. Most of our Parish Staff and a few guests not officially on staff but daily workers with our staff took a trip to Pointe Coupée before we began the celebration of Christmas. We had the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist at the old chapel of St. Francis of Pointe Coupée. The chapel was originally established in 1738 at the old French Fort midway between Natchez and New Orleans, and this present building dates from 1890. On the National Register of Historic Places, the St. Francis congregation is the oldest congregation in the Diocese of Baton Rouge, though now part of St. Mary of False River. After Eucharist we gathered for a nice meal.

As we moved toward Christmas, the St. Vincent de Paul/ Food Bank ministers were among the first to gather,

followed by the Knights of Columbus, the Catholic Daughters, some of our Bible Study Groups, Immaculate Student Ministry, the Ladies Altar Guild, and the Early Learning Center Staff. It is good when those who work, serve, study and minister together can gather and relax, thanking God who calls us together as one, just as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit love and share as one God.



As we neared Christmas our youth who are going on the March for Life in January helped serve breakfast with St. Nicholas. It was nice joining them for the morning. While a fund raiser, there was a good spirit present among the youth. While the trip in January's main focus is participation in the March for Life, I have said time and again, that this trip is for them much more than simply this. They have the opportunity to travel with many youth from around the Diocese and eat, visit, pray and speak together as family. Most of the seminarians from the Diocese participate in the trip, and this gives them the opportunity to know them better. Perhaps one day they will all serve together in parish ministries and look back on the days and time they traveled together to Washington praying and sharing along the way. To me this is a good experience of the broader Church family for our youth.

May our sharing of the Eucharist during this Christmas Season nourish and deepen within each of us those family values which we will one day live in perfect love and communion with God and the saints.
