## CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: MOVING AHEAD

**This Sunday, as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (another Epiphany/ Manifestation/ Revelation of the Lord),**



we bring the Christmas Season to its conclusion, and on Monday move ahead into Ordinary Time. It has been a good Christmas Season and **I offer a word of thanks in the name of all** to the Musicians, Liturgical Ministers and Décor ministers who helped prepare the assembly and parish campus for the Christmas celebrations. They have been good and blessed days and I know

we had many visitors from out of town and from other faiths who commented on the wonderful experience they have had with us.



It was good seeing the Men's Club and Youth assisting with the décor both inside and outside the church. These have been good days and I (we) thank all who have been a part of them in so many ways. We also thank those who gave gifts for the Angel Tree

and Peanut Butter to the Mighty Moms as they prepared for their holiday distribution.

**This Sunday our Confirmation Candidates will meet at the Cathedral** for the noon Eucharist with their sponsors and many with their families. They will receive Confirmation this Friday evening at 7:00 from Bishop Muench. Let us remember them in our prayers on this special day – a special day not only for them, but for us and for those whose lives they will touch in the years to come. It will be a pleasure to celebrate this Eucharist with them and to have assisted in their preparation. Many thanks to Gwen Richard, the teachers, staff and families who have been a part of their preparation.

**On Monday, following the 8:30 Eucharist, I will be leaving for Biloxi and the annual Formation Days for the priests of the Diocese. Fr. Raj and I will both be gone** Monday at 9:00 through Thursday, returning Thursday evening. As in past years, these days are mandatory. Bishop Muench has published a letter concerning these days in The Commentator, and I just wanted to call it to your attention. In case of sacramental emergencies, you can still call the emergency number and Deacon Rudy will try and get a priest to assist you. Several religious priests who are not required to attend these days will be available in case of emergencies, and Deacon Rudy will try and contact them for you. Hospital chaplains should first be contacted if the persons requesting sacramental assistance are in the hospital. Funerals with Eucharist can be scheduled before or after the Formation Days, and Funeral Services without Eucharist can be scheduled with one of our parish deacons.

**“Come Follow Me” is a retreat aimed for young men, 16 years and older, who are discerning God's will in their lives.** God calls us all to life and happiness. Yet, we sometimes wonder, where will I best find happiness. What Christian lifestyle will best lead me to this goal? This retreat is being sponsored by the Dioceses of Baton Rouge and Lake Charles. 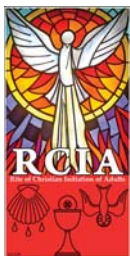

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**

The Catechumenate sessions focus on Jesus, His teachings, the Church and the sacraments. During this phase, the catechumen/candidate will take part in the Sunday liturgy of the Word although they do not participate in the Eucharist. They will leave the assembly after the homily with a blessing, and they will continue to explore the meaning of the Scripture readings, “breaking open the Word.” This dismissal is a powerful sign and public witness to the community of faith of the sincerity and determination of those seeking to become Catholic. It shows that they are seriously pursuing their call and preparing to become full-fledged, committed Catholics. As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord today, let us recall our own Baptism. 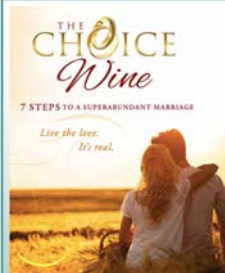
