CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: EASTER WELCOMES

As we continue through the Easter Season, on this Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord we celebrate the Lord's Ascension to the Father, and his promise to welcome us one day into our heavenly home as his brothers and sisters, all loving children of the Father, having been redeemed in the Easter Mystery. It is good to be able to reflect what we anticipate by sharing that welcome here in the parish, in our homes, our schools, in the workplace – in our lives. As you know, our parish Mission Statement begins, "Immaculate Conception Parish and the Mission of the Sacred Heart is a welcoming community..." We have some good and graced experiences of welcome to share this week:

WELCOMING NEW PARISHIONERS is done in many ways. We send them a welcome letter with a copy of the Parish Guide Book and Directory, we seek to reach out to them and involve them in ministry and most recently, toward the end of April we had our **Welcome Luau** for those families who had recently registered in the parish. Lord, we recall how he sent those first disciples to be his witnesses and to share all he had entrusted to them. We thank these new ministers and all in our parish ministries who follow in that same tradition of witnessing and sharing.

WE WILL BE HAPPY TO WELCOME seminarian Joseph Bergan to the parish this summer. He will be spending eight weeks with us as he gets to know and experience life in the different parishes of the Diocese. Joseph will be going into his third year of college (philosophy) when he leaves us, and we both welcome him and wish him a good, happy and graced time with us.

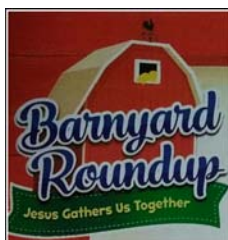
