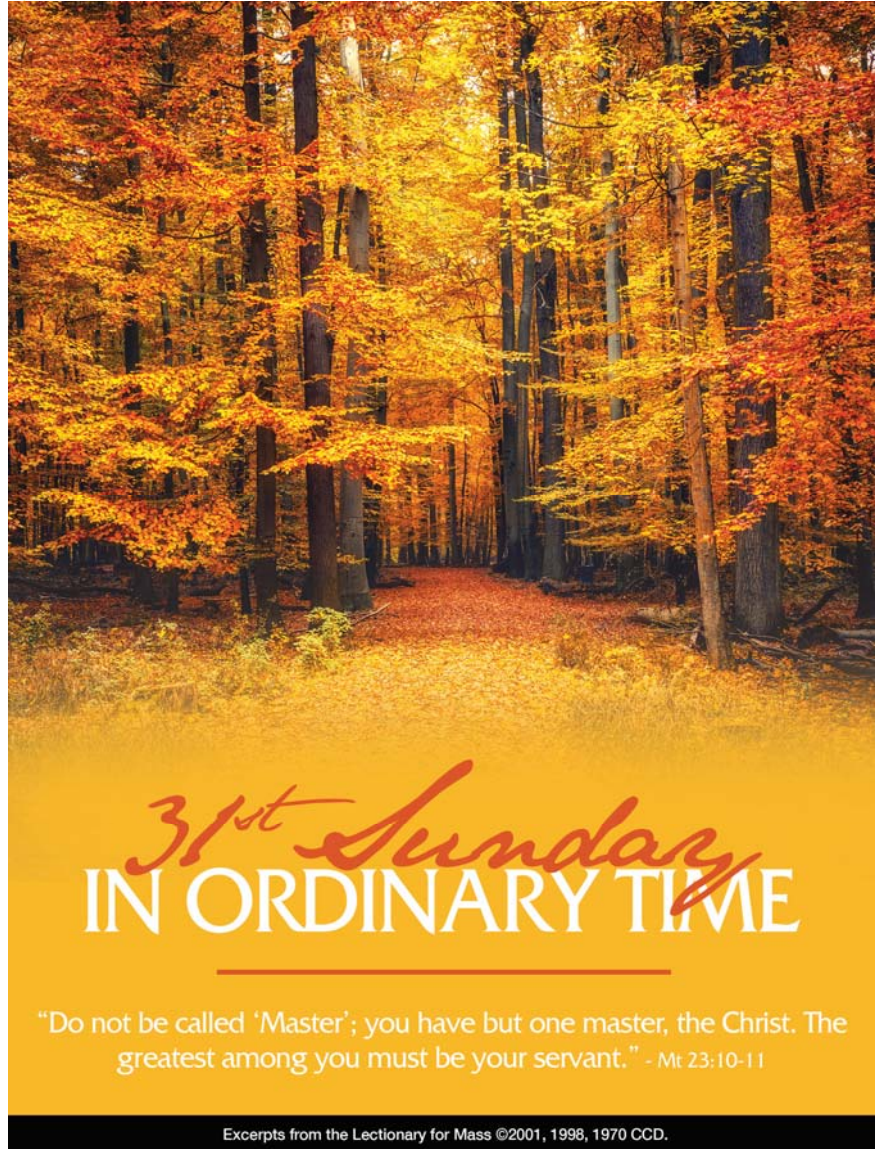

Stump the Deacon!

If a deacon can perform a wedding ceremony, why can't a deacon celebrate a Mass?

In 1983, the Church established the most recent Code of Canon Law that established the rules to be followed by our Catholic church. Canon Law specifically limits the celebration of Mass to an ordained priest; priests are the only ones that can consecrate the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. Canon Law states “The minister who is able to confect the sacrament of the Eucharist [the Mass] in the person of Christ is a validly ordained priest alone.” (Canon 900.1)

During a marriage ceremony, the actual ministers of the sacrament are the couple being married by expressing their mutual consent. When at least one party is Catholic, a marriage is valid when contracted before the bishop, or the parish, or a priest or deacon (with proper delegation) and before two witnesses. (Canon 1108.1) A deacon, therefore, can validly officiate at a Catholic marriage ceremony, as long as he has been delegated to do so by the pastor.
