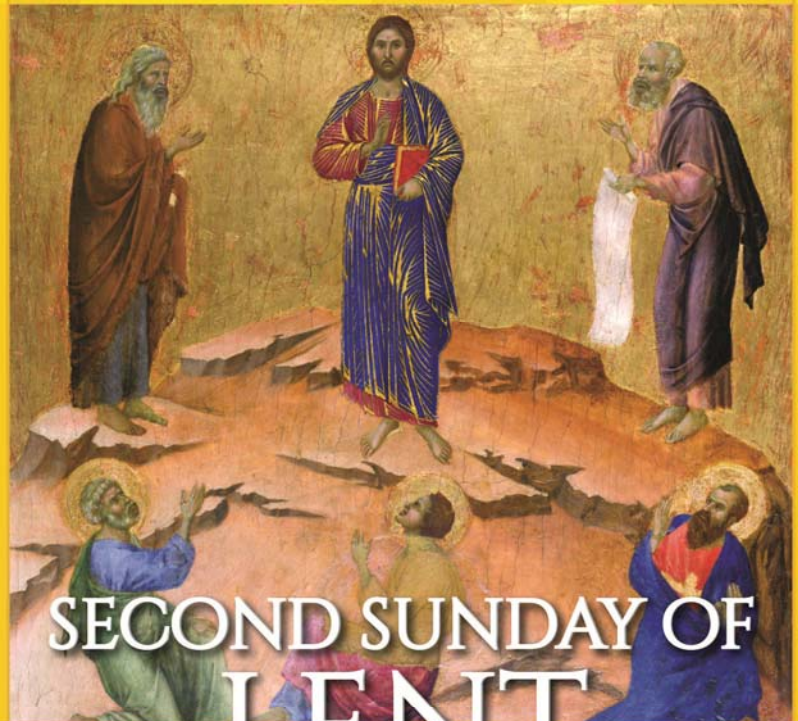

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: A Lenten Journey

**This Sunday as we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent, we take time to renew our (re) Commitment to Ministry.** The Lord is transfigured on the mountain in today's Gospel, and through our ministries we have the opportunity to assist him in transfiguring the world. We join in thanking you for your good stewardship and many ministries in the parish and larger community, both the official and unofficial ones.

**Last Sunday was another big step for our Candidates and Catechumens.** They went to the Cathedral where they were presented to the Bishop who recognized them as the Elect who would be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church at Easter, either through Baptism and the other sacraments of initiation or by a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

**There will be an Andrew Dinner for those thinking about a possible vocation to the priesthood on Sunday, March 4.** Every now and then Fr. Andrew Merrick who served here after ordination and is now Vocation Director, and Bishop Muench co-host a dinner for those thinking and praying about a possible vocation to the priesthood. **Anyone interested in going or having questions about it can call Fr. Andrew at 344-1920 or me at 665-5359.** I would also be happy to answer any questions and even go with you to the dinner if you would like and my calendar says o.k.

**We received a call from the Oblates last Friday, February 09,** that **Fr. Ronald Walker, O.M.I.,** pastor



here at Immaculate Conception from 1978-1982, was called to his reward. His funeral was Friday, February 16 in San Antonio where their Novitiate and Provincial House is located. Fr. Ronald Walker did a lot for our parish in the four years he served as pastor. He brought the GIFT PROGRAM to the parish, helping the parish organize in smaller faith sharing groups, which helped parishioners really be gift to each other and together

to the parish and larger community. I was pastor in New Roads when he was pastor here. I remember well going to meetings with him and being really impressed with his

comments and spirituality. We keep him and the Oblates who served us so well in our prayers.

**Over the Mardi Gras holidays, Joseph Bergan** was home from the seminary and came to the 8:30 Eucharist Lundi



Gras, and we had a good visit afterwards. It was timely because **the Abbey Youth Fest will be held on Saturday, March 17, and this year Joseph is in charge of**

**the Liturgical arrangements for the day.** When he was here he did a lot with our youth, going to visit everyone from young students in the Launch Program, Summer Vacation Bible School to participating in Immaculate Student Ministry nights in the Youth Center. Even after the flood, he came and spoke to our Confirmation Class about the floods they had experienced at the seminary several months before ours. He is both a good friend of the parish



and our youth, and it is nice that he will be responsible for planning some of the Abbey Fest Day for our youth. **Though advertised elsewhere in the Sunday bulletins as we near the day, youth interested in attending are**

**encouraged to contact Kevin Acord or Gwen Richard via the parish office, 665-5359, at PSR, or at Youth Nights.** Abbey Youth Fest has always been a good day and we are happy many of our seminarians are involved in planning and presenting it. **Deadline for pre-registration is March 9<sup>th</sup>.**

**This Thursday, March 1, I give thanks for 49 years of ordained ministry** in service to the parishioners of the Diocese of Baton Rouge. They have been good years, and I cannot believe how quickly they have passed.
