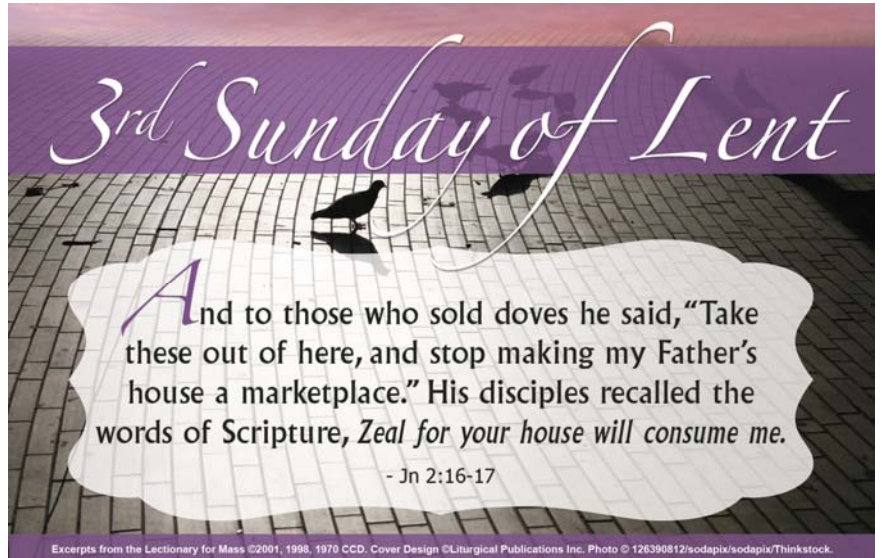


Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Time of Purification



As we begin this Third Week of Lent, I wanted to share this photograph of our Elect and Candidates for Full Communion who were presented to the Bishop in a beautiful service, the Rites of Election, the First Sunday of Lent. Originally the Lenten Season was known as the "Time of Purification" because in early days, the Elect were prayerfully preparing for the Easter Vigil. In time, the idea of a time of purification spread to the whole Church as we prepared to renew our Baptismal Commitments as they received Baptism. Thus we could all be "on the same page" together. To borrow a phrase we often hear around Christmas, our Elect and Candidates are "the reason for the season." Let us keep them all in our prayers, especially those whose names we have received.

Congratulations to our Boy Scouts as they continue on with good activities. They recently enjoyed a trip to New Orleans and the World War II museum. We soon may have
