Consideration of our Christian Commitment: A Lenten Journey

This Sunday's Scriptures all speak to us of God's mercy, expressed in different ways. Stories with second chances encourage us, as we know that we often need them. Many of us know firsthand about going our own way when it is not the right way. Perhaps we did not deliberately start out with the wrong path in mind, but we made some bad choices. And when we added more bad choices, we may have found ourselves further from home than we had anticipated. We found it hard to return to the good path, perhaps even doubting whether we belonged there at all. But no matter how far we might stray, beauty and truth call out to us like a beacon in the storm. Their deep imprints upon our soul allow us to recognize that our own ways are not working; we need God and we cannot sustain ourselves without Him. These deep imprints keep reminding us that there is hope – and that we can go home after all.

Journeys are always better when made with others, and I think a beautiful aspect of our Friday evening Lenten Suppers is the opportunity to gather and come into contact with organizations and ministries in the parish, as well as with one another. Even if we pick up our meals as "take outs," we still have the opportunity to visit in line, and meet those who are preparing and serving them. We thank



delivered and cooking meals which were served in the evening.

The meal this past Friday was provided by the RCIA, and on the 23rd the Men's Club will provide our last Lenten Supper. While they raise funds for their ministries to the parish with these suppers, they are a good occasion of coming together and mutual support. **Many thanks to the Men's Club** who worked to clean the pool and fountain in the Prayer Garden.

We remind you that this Friday, instead of a Lenten Supper we will have the blessing of the annual St. Joseph Altar. The Stations of the Cross will be at 6:30, and the

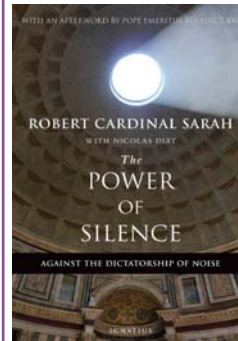

Stump the Deacon!

What is the procedure for appointing Bishop Muench’s replacement?

The complete answer is rather lengthy, so this week I concentrate on where candidates come from, next week, the actual process.

The Pope’s ambassador to the United States (the apostolic nuncio) already has files on every bishop who could be transferred and on many priests who have been suggested as a potential bishop. Each year all of the bishops of a province (in our case, Louisiana) acting together at a meeting may nominate up to three more, which the archbishop must forward to the nuncio or to the Congregation for Bishops in Rome.

The nuncio is responsible for carrying out a suitable background check on any proposed candidate who is not yet a bishop, usually first by contacting that man’s own bishop and the Chancery or religious institute’s office where his personnel files are located, asking for copies.

When a particular diocese is under consideration for a new bishop, the nuncio typically consults with the outgoing bishop and the archbishop of that province. Standard questionnaires about the diocese are obtained. Additionally, the nuncio usually sends that same questionnaire about the diocese to ten or so priests and lay diocesan officials.

The leadership of the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) and the Cardinals in the United States who are also diocesan bishops are usually given a chance to offer their suggestions as well. The nuncio, in fact, can consult as few or as many persons as he wishes to.
