As mentioned last weekend, this weekend we welcome Fr. Aloysius Nzekwe of the Mission Society of St. Paul to present to us our annual Mission Appeal. Our church is missionary by nature. Each of us as baptized Catholics are called to share in the work of evangelization. The diocese of Baton Rouge collaborates with mission groups every year to raise funds for their missions through a program called the Missionary Cooperative Plan. The group assigned to our parish this year is the Missionary Society of St. Paul. **Fr. Aloysius Nzekwe, MSP** will be speaking to us this weekend. **There will be a second collection to support them in their work.** The Missionary Society of St. Paul (MSP) is a congregation of priests founded in Nigeria in 1977. The Society now has 260 priests. They are working in ten countries of Africa, (South Africa, Malawi, Botswana,

Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, The Gambia, Nigeria, Kenya, and Southern Sudan), Grenada in the West Indies, the United States, England, Sweden, and Ireland. They also have about 127 seminarians in their seminary in Nigeria.

Their mission in Malawi provides rehabilitation and support for over 300 orphans who lost their parents due to AIDS. They need our financial assistance to continue this mission. They also need funds to: 1) provide fresh water wells, and education in rural communities of Chad, Malawi, South Sudan, Kenya, and Nigeria; 2) sponsor seminarians, our future priests; 3) support priests in the founding/building of new churches. Your support will be an immense help to the Missionary Society of St. Paul as they bring the good news to those desperately in need of it.

CHRISTIAN OLYMPICS, RUNNING FOR THE GOLD is the theme for Summer Vacation Bible School this year. Join us as we "Run for the Gold" June 18-22,



from 9:00 a.m. till noon. Enjoy Bible stories, games, music, arts & crafts and snacks throughout the week. We will be welcoming students who will be entering K-5th grades in the fall. The fee is \$15.00 per child. Registration forms can be found on the link on the parish website, www.icc-msh.org/formation.

Registration is April 23-June 8, and registration deadline is June 8. No registrations will be taken at the door as materials will need to be ordered ahead of time.
