Do you have concerns about falling? Many older adults experience concerns about falling and restrict their activities. A Matter of Balance is an award-winning program designed to manage falls and increase activity levels. This program is for people 60 or older.

You Will Learn to:

- View falls as controllable
- Set goals for increasing activity
- Make changes to reduce fall risks at home
- Exercise to increase strength and balance

Who Should Attend?

- Anyone concerned about falls
- Anyone interested in improving balance, flexibility and strength
- Anyone who has fallen in the past
- Anyone who has restricted activities because of falling concerns

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: The Day of Pentecost

As we bring the Easter Season to its conclusion on this Day of the Pentecost, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit, our most welcome guest. In the life of the Church, Christmas, Easter, and Pentecost are designated as solemnities of equal rank and importance. They present us with loving action of the Holy Trinity, of a loving God who gave us his only begotten Son whose mission it was to fill us with God's life-giving Spirit. Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church. The Apostles had locked themselves up in the upper room in fear until the Holy Spirit filled them with the gifts needed to accomplish our loving God's purpose. Pope Francis continues to encourage us to engage in our culture, not to condemn it, but to love it enough to save it. We live in a world in need of healing, and we pray that as the Holy Spirit brought unity and purpose into the lives of those first disciples, that same Spirit may help us, the Church, here and throughout the world to share that healing mercy which has been first shared with us.

This coming Saturday, May 26, John Vu will be ordained to the Diaconate. He is a really good young man who is completing his studies at Notre Dame Seminary and will be ordained to the priesthood next spring. **Other good news is that Deacon John will be doing his diaconate internship**



with us as Father Matthew McCaughey did seven years ago. He will be arriving here in the parish on June 4th and remaining with us through the summer months before returning to Notre Dame in October to complete his studies. While among us, he will serve in the usual diaconate ministries we have enjoyed with our permanent deacons

– assisting at the Eucharist, proclaiming the Gospel, preaching, baptizing and conducting funerals and weddings without Eucharist. Deacon John is from St. Anthony of Padua and Le Van Phung Parish in Baton Rouge, and his brother, Joseph Vu is serving as pastor of the Clustered Parishes of St. Philomena in Labadieville, St. Ann in Napoleonville and Assumption in Plattenville. We are very happy to have him with us and wish him good and graced

months with us. His Internship with us will be an important part of his preparation for priestly ordination and many in the parish will be asked to participate in his internship in different ways. **Participating in his internship will make us a part of his priestly ministry long after we are gone. If you wish to be a part of his internship from the very beginning, he would be happy to have you attend his diaconate ordination this coming Saturday, May 26 at 10:00 at St. Joseph Cathedral.**

Seminarian Joseph Bergan who spent the summer with us a few years ago, graduated May 11 from St. Joseph Seminary College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Philosophy and the Liberal Arts. Usually in the summer, students will either do mission work, serve in a parish or have a special project. As of this writing, I am not sure where he will be assigned, but wherever he goes I know he will be a blessing to them. While with us, he was really active and good with our youth, from Summer Vacation Bible School youth to our high school youth group. He even visited and spent time with the Launch Program. He will be going to Notre Dame Seminary at the end of the summer to begin his four years of Theology.
