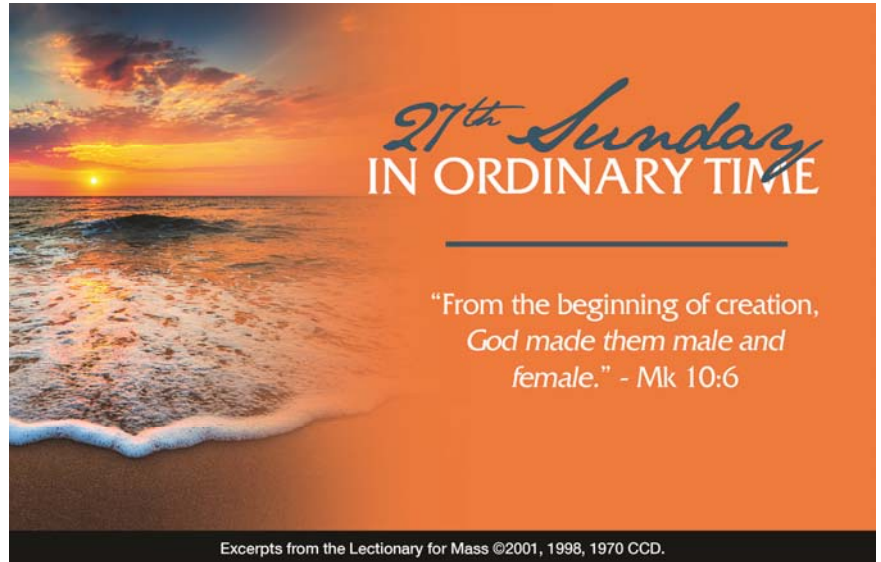

This Sunday in the first reading, God creates woman. Just imagine for a minute what a different world it would be if instead of God saying, "It is not good for the man to be alone. our life, it is easy to sit down, grab our phones and check to see who recently updated their Facebook page or tweeted something we just have to know. I have nothing against smart phones but it is important that we engage one another in conversation much like Jesus would engage those around him in conversation and listen intently to what they have to say. Likewise, when we have a free moment, instead of trolling the internet, we can talk to God about our day, what we did right, who we helped, how we made his world a better place and how we can do better tomorrow.

Just a reminder: This Saturday, October 13, we will have a farewell reception for Deacon John in the large hall following the Anticipated Eucharist. We have appreciated having his service with us these five months, and



as he leaves us to return to the seminary, we wish him well as we look forward to his ordination May 25, at 10:00, in St. Joseph Cathedral. We pray that he brings a bit of us back with him to Notre Dame and into his priestly ministry in the coming years. We hope you can come Saturday, and thank the Catholic Daughters for hosting us.

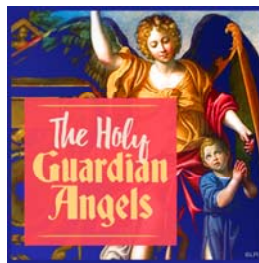

When I was a child,
my mother prayed the
Guardian Angel prayer with me.
Do we really have guardian angels?

I think we do, and the Catholic Church does too because we celebrate the Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels on October 2nd each year. In the gospel of that day, Jesus speaks about the little children when He says “See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father.” That certainly appears to me that Jesus was speaking about guardian angels, and Jesus cannot speak an untruth.

Guardian angels have been part of our thinking from the beginning. Origen, the great Scripture commentator of the 2nd century writes, “For each of us in the Church of God, no matter how small, there is a good angel of the Lord who stands daily before the face of God to rule and move and govern, to correct our actions and intercede for us in our sufferings.” Christian tradition does not limit guardian angels to just those in the Church as Origen stated, but that all humans have a guardian angel. St. Jerome writes, “What a great dignity of souls that each person has, from birth, an angel assigned as a guardian!”

If you are like me, you probably don't think much about your guardian angel. In fact, you may not have thought about your angel for years. But at least today, let us thank our guardian angel for always being with us, helping us, protecting us, even though we don't always know it or recognize it. Let us pray:

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love entrusts me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen +
