It is our challenge as Christians, to couch everything we do, all the spiritual gifts we bring to the Church, our families or schools and workplaces, with the gift of love. As we enter a new week, it might be good to ask God to accompany us on our way with his gift of love, so that everything we do can in one way or another be life giving to others.

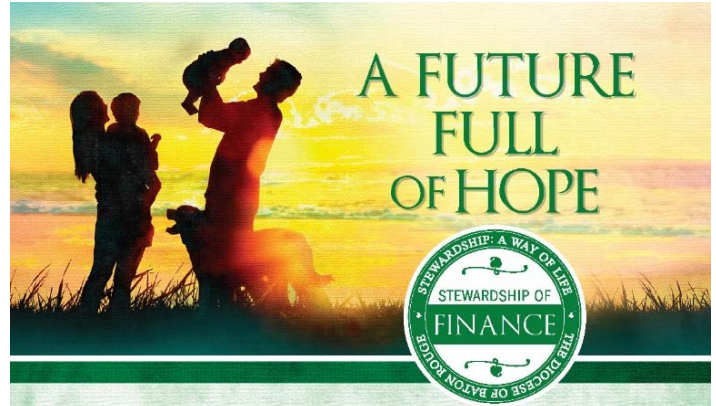
Blood Donors are encouraged to participate in our Blood Drive this Sunday in the main hall between 8:30 and 12:30 p.m. This is an important ministry that works hand in hand with Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center, our K.C.'s, and our Parish Nurse. This ministry benefits the entire parish, for the Lake's Blood Center provides coverage to registered members of the parish who need to receive and replace blood. In a lot of ways it is one of the important Outreach ministries of the parish to its own. I have given blood regularly since I was old enough to give blood, and for me it is a quick and painless way to be of service to many. We thank all those who donate as well as those who serve in this ministry to the parish.

TWO PILGRIMAGES ON THE HORIZON: As you may know, there are two pilgrimages which will be going to Europe later this year. I feel most parishioners know about our parish pilgrimage to France June 12-22, visiting Lourdes, Nevers, Lisieux, Paris and other sites along the way. We have brochures available in the parish office and can put you in touch with the tour company if you wish more information. We have 35 persons going on the trip which includes several of our parish staff and myself.

There is another pilgrimage later this year to Italy, Rome and Assisi lead by Fr. Vincent Dufresne, former pastor here at Immaculate Conception. He will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy, October 16-25, 2019. This is an excellent opportunity for "First-Timers" to visit the Eternal City and the home of St. Francis & St. Clare. All the essential experiences will be included: a Papal Audience in Rome, visits to St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museum, visits to the other major basilicas of the city as well as classic historic sites. In Assisi, we will visit the religious sites associated with St. Francis, and visit St. Clare's convent and her place of burial. Even if you have been before, October is the best time to spend two weeks in Italy!

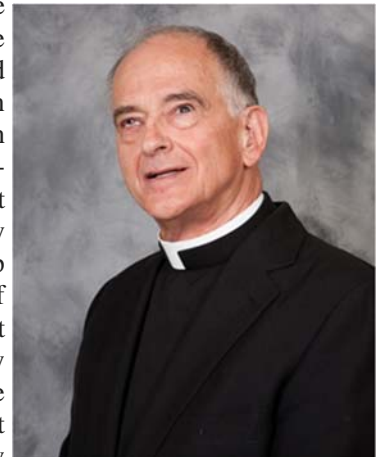

What is the RCIA Rite of Sending? The Rite of Sending offers the parish community an opportunity to acknowledge the spiritual progress the catechumens and candidates have made, express approval of their election or recognition, and send them forth to the bishop with their support. To send a catechumen to the bishop means that a parish has discerned that the person is ready to enter the Catholic Church. In Sacred Scripture, the Book of Revelations makes reference to a “Book of Life”, in which are written the names of those who have chosen to follow the Lord Jesus and be baptized. In this Rite, those preparing for Baptism are invited to come forward and sign a book which we call the “Book of the Elect” as a sign of their desire to be numbered among the chosen of God. Those already baptized had their names written in the Book of Life at their Baptism.

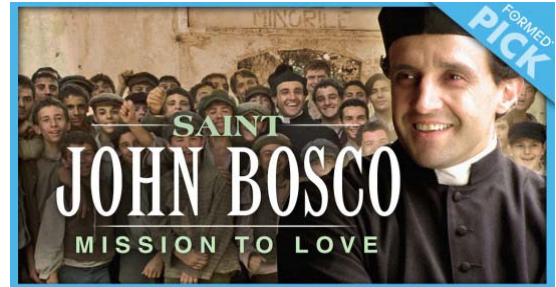

Stump the Deacon!



Each of us has a guardian angel that helps guide us to good thoughts and works, and preserves us from evil. Should we name our guardian angel?

The practice of assigning names to our guardian angel is discouraged. *The Directory of Popular Piety and the Liturgy* states: "The practice of assigning names to the Holy Angels should be discouraged, except in the cases of Gabriel,

Raphael and Michael whose names are contained in Holy Scripture."

Why does the Church discourage this? *Catholic Answers Magazine* in its January-February issue addresses this question. "For one thing, angels already have their own names and, barring special revelation, that name is unknowable to us. Naming a person also implies authority over that person, and humans don't have that authority over angels. But that doesn't mean Catholics can't address their angels. For example, guardian angels can be addressed as either 'Guardian' or 'Angel'" or similar terms.

The name of our guardian angel should not be that important. What is important is that we are surrounded by their watchful care and intercession, and we can call on them in our time of need.
