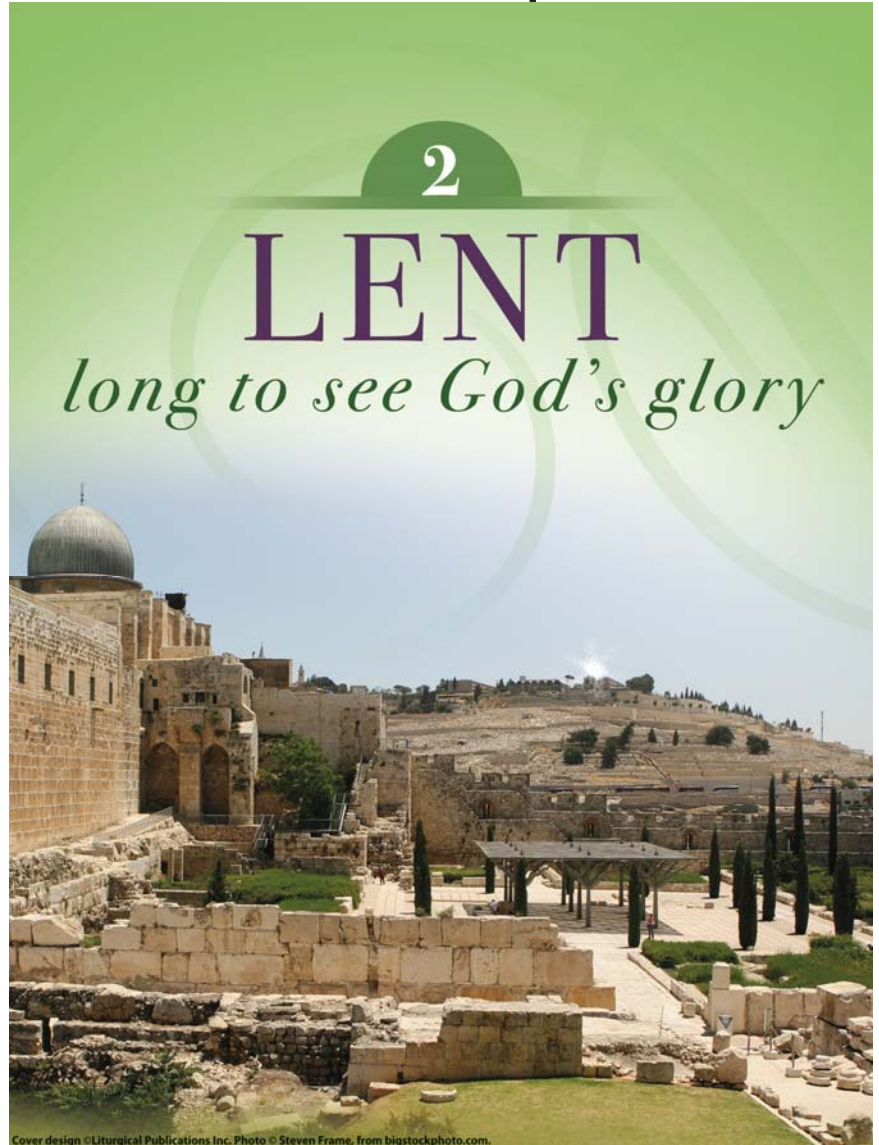

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: A Lenten Journey

This Sunday as we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent we take time to renew our (re) Commitment to Ministry. The Lord is transfigured on the mountain in today's Gospel, and through our ministries we have the opportunity to assist him in transfiguring the world. We join in thanking you for your good stewardship and many ministries in the parish and larger community, both the official and unofficial ones.

Last Sunday was another big step for our Candidates and Catechumens. They went to the Cathedral where they were presented to Bishop Duca who recognized them as the Elect who would be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church at Easter, either through Baptism and the other sacraments of initiation or by a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church, Confirmation and Eucharist.

As we prepared to begin Lent, the Men's Club worked to get the Prayer Garden and Fountain in good shape for those who will be visiting the Prayer



Garden during the Lenten Season. We offer special thanks to **Tina Guillory** and **Joe Lowe** for their work with the eleventh station which needed replacing.

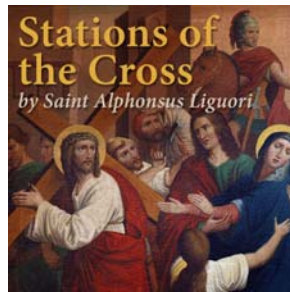
