

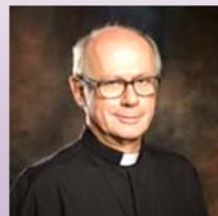

Consideration of Our Christian Commitment: A Lenten Journey



Our Lenten Journey has been all the more special due to the presence of our Elect and Candidates for Full Communion who are journeying with us. The beginning of March on the First Sunday of Lent, they were presented to



Bishop Duca at the Rites of Election celebrated at the Cathedral. There they were officially accepted for this last stage of their journey by the Bishop. Not able to attend the Rites of Election, but with us in spirit was **Peggy Hastings**, who received the Anointing of the Sick from me at Our Lady of the Lake as I was headed to the Cathedral for the Rites of Election. Peggy had suffered a

minor stroke the day before and was about to be discharged when I arrived. We give thanks for these, our Elect and Candidates for Full Communion with us, and pray with and for them as we move together toward Easter. They are a great group, and we thank our R.C.I.A. team who has worked with them these eight months.

Father Jean-Baptiste Saint-Jure was a Jesuit priest born in Metz, France in 1588. He was rector of a number of Jesuit colleges, a spiritual director and spiritual writer, and

died April 3, 1657, in Paris. The other day, Deacon Rudy quoted from one of his books, and I thought it would be nice to share the quote with you: *“We trust ourselves to a doctor because we suppose he knows his business. He orders an operation which involves cutting away part of our body, and we accept it. We are grateful to him and pay him a large fee because we judge he would not act as he does unless the remedy were necessary, and we must rely on his skill. Yet we are unwilling to treat God in the same way! It looks as if we do not trust His wisdom and are afraid He cannot do His job properly. We allow ourselves to be operated on by a man who may easily make a mistake- a mistake which may cost us our life- and protest when God sets to work on us. If we could see all He sees, we would unhesitatingly wish all He wishes.”*

Next Sunday, Bishop Duca will be joining us for the 11:00 Eucharist, and Father Frank Santucci will be preaching all the Sunday Liturgies. After, we will gather in the pavilion to celebrate The Grill Is On for You. All of this will be celebrating the coming of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate to Livingston Parish in May of 1919. I hope you can join us.

Fr. Santucci will also give us our Parish Lenten Mission on April 1, 2, and 3rd, taking the best of the spirituality of the Oblates and sharing it with us in terms of our own lives and mission. I hope you can join us then. Let us keep our Elect, our Candidates, and one another in prayer. Love,

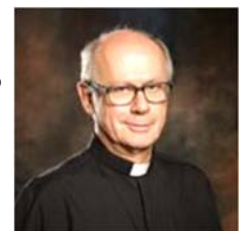

Stump the Deacon!

As Jesus was dying on the cross, He cried out in a loud voice “My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?”

Was Jesus despondent and despairing?

It may seem that way, but He was not despairing. According to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* “Despair is contrary to God’s goodness, to His justice...and to His mercy.” (CCC 2091) Jesus could never do anything against the Father’s goodness and mercy. Jesus was actually quoting from Psalm 22: “My God, My God, why have You abandoned me? Why so far from my call for help, from my cries of anguish.” (Ps 22:1)

I want to quote from *The Stations of the Cross with Pope John Paul II*: Jesus, as a faithful Jew, would have prayed the Psalms regularly. It is no surprise, then, that these words from Psalm 22 are on His lips during the intense agony of His last moments. While this cry might seem to be a sign of despair or hopelessness, it reveals, rather, the depth of His anguish and the intensity of His pain. Shortly, afterward, He surrenders totally to His Father’s will— “Father, into Your hands, I commend My spirit.” We might wish to follow Christ’s example, letting these words be the last on our lips as we wait each night for sleep to come, sleep which is a symbol of our eventual death! (Thirteenth Station, Jesus Dies on the Cross)
