Wedding cake and coffee will be served after.


This will be an unusual but wonderful event and can potentially be a big fundraiser for our parish.



Dear Friends in the Lord:

Next week we are taking up our annual collection for the *Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa*. The Church in Africa is growing rapidly, but too often there are not enough local pastoral resources to support people in their faith.
