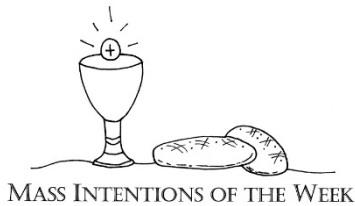

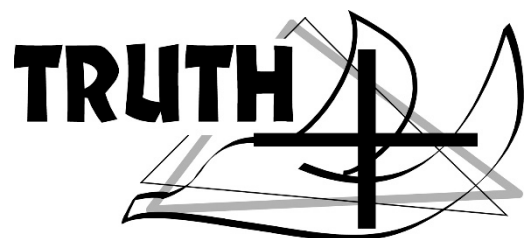


Not every family in our parish is able to afford the registration fees which cover the expense of books and supplies. If you would like to "adopt" a child/family this year it would be most appreciated!!

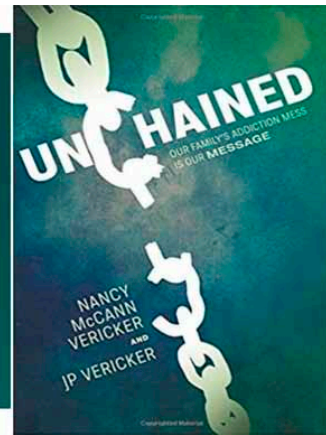

Listen to Nancy McCann Vericker Author of UNCHAINED share her personal story as a woman in recovery whose son's battles addiction. In her book - the riveting true story of a young man's descent into addiction, homelessness and violence, and his recovery journey—told by a son, now seven years sober and co-founder of a substance abuse treatment program, and his mother, a spiritual director and youth minister with more than twenty-six years of sobriety.

Get trained on administering Narcan. Narcan is the brand name for naloxone, an opioid antagonist medication used to reverse the effects of opioid overdose. When somebody overdoses on an opioid drug like heroin or prescription painkillers, the drug depresses the respiratory and central nervous systems, disrupting breathing and potentially leading to death. You can save a life!

Participants will receive Narcan Training provided by Anne-Marie VanOrden, Family Navigator, of the Alcoholism & Drug Abuse of Council of Orange County.
