Weekly Collections for December 2018



Thank you for your support!! Dollar by dollar we are getting closer to our weekly collection goal of \$14,734. I am happy to report that our Christmas collection exceeded our budgeted amount of \$25,000 by over \$6,000 for a total of \$31,102!! The added Christmas collection put our income ahead of our expenses for this month. Unfortunately, however, that profit margin doesn't offset a projected deficit for the year given the weekly shortfalls in our *weekly* collections. (If only Christmas came every month?!) Thankfully, however, we are heading in the right direction!!

Additional Funds/Donations for December 2018:

- \$3,861.00 from the second collection at Christmas for Parish Outreach.
- \$15,140.00 in restricted funds came in towards the church roof repair.
- \$300.00 was donated anonymously towards the oil bill for December.
- \$200.00 was donated anonymously towards the phone bill.
- \$200.00 was donated towards the phone bill in memory of *Lucille Carpinelli and Frank Zammit*.
- \$100.00 was donated towards the Sunday Missals in memory of *Eleanor & Joseph Maffei*.

A future bulletin will provide an update on our Renew and Rebuild Campaign contributions.

In addition to these monthly financial reports, you will also receive a monthly report in our Sunday bulletin on our sacramental and parish outreach efforts. Your sacrifice of time, talent, and treasure are such an important part of securing our parish mission of *building a community of hope* here in Monroe and Orange County. Thank you again!!
