Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

I have often appreciated nature as a template or example of ways to approach life. The patterns we can observe in natural cycles are reliable and free of bias or opinion. Many times the image of a pebble tossed in water, generating concentric circles of ripples can help us see the effect that a small effort on our part can initiate.

This image comes to mind especially these days, as blunt and hurtful words are so casually used. No wonder anger and retaliation are often first responses to an interchange of opinions. When teaching 4th and 5th graders recently, I was amazed at how quickly they can come up with sharp and dismissive retorts. In my mind I call it the "*Simpsons*" effect. We have several generations brought up on comedy based on belittling others.

What I wonder is if we might be moved to initiate some kinder, gentler ripples in this pond of life? Each of us knows how quickly we can *fly off the handle*. Perhaps we can use some conscious focus to absorb the negative ripples that head our way, and instead find a smile or a shrug of shoulders which send out a message of "*Oh well, it's okay*".

Our efforts may appear small, but nature shows us that the effect can be great.

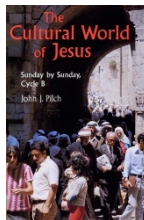
CLEAN DRINKING WATER BENEFIT FOR HAITIAN FAMILIES
