Second Sunday of Advent

Occasionally I hear or see something that makes me ponder folks' understanding of the concept of God. Our Catholic understanding of God includes the fundamental beliefs that God is all-good, all-knowing, all-powerful, and ever-present; the Creator of all things visible and invisible. This is the God who loves us eternally and who has created us in God's own image. Humanity is uniquely gifted by God with the potential to be holy, like God.

I believe that the gift which makes us *most* like God is the gift of our free will. God freely chooses to love and create; God always chooses to do what is right, just, merciful and kind. Exercising our gift of free will to love and create, to do what is right, just, merciful and kind is the best way for us to give glory to God. The awesome responsibility we have is to develop our inner and outer lives to more and more reflect the goodness of God. As humans, this takes us time, requires practice, causes us suffering through errors and remains always within our choice to accept or reject God's presence.

And so we come to Advent, our journey toward Christmas. This gift of God, taking on human flesh in the Incarnation, reveals God's continuing and intense love of humanity and desire for our salvation from sin. Jesus reveals God as we Christians have come to know the Divine, as Trinity: the Father, the Son and Holy Spirit. No greater gift has ever been given at Christmas!

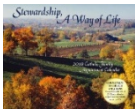
