## Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the regular practice of our faith we learn our prayers, we experience community and we deepen our relationship with Jesus, our Lord and Savior! Through our **Baptism** we are each gifted with the Holy Spirit of God. At **Reconciliation** we seek to mend any breaks in our relationship with God. When we receive **Eucharist** we are nourished in body and soul with the very life of God. When choosing to be **Confirmed** we personally declare our belief in belonging to the Body of Christ and accept anew the Holy Spirit's gifts. In times of physical need we are invited to receive the **Anointing of the Sick** to strengthen us.

As we grow into maturity we discover ways by which our life choices can give glory to God. Two sacramental choices are presented by our faith tradition. **Matrimony** allows a man and a woman to commit their love to one another for life, while men may feel the call to serve the People of God through **Ordination**. Our Roman Catholic tradition highlights these seven sacred experiences in life with the celebration of rites we call *Sacraments*.

Rather than finding weekly (or even daily) Eucharist as repetitive and unexciting, can we approach the experience as an opportunity to meet God? How can we help ourselves and our loved ones to know Jesus better? What sort of challenge of discovery would capture our hearts and attention? *If you have an answer to any of these questions, be sure to announce the Good News to others!*
