FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR: There is a long tradition that liturgies celebrated in parishes are to model the liturgies of the Diocesan Bishop. If you have ever attended a Mass at the Cathedral or other liturgy at which the Bishop presides, you may notice his style and some of the routines he uses. Disregarding anything that is directly related to some routines that are done only when the bishop is present [i.e. presenting the gifts of bread and wine to the bishop at the presider's chair], there are other routines we are to model [i.e. ringing of the consecration bells]. These routines are being incorporated into the revised instructions for the Altar Servers. For this reason Deacon Greg and I are asking that all Altar Servers, including new Servers, attend one of the upcoming training sessions. Students in Faith Formation may be excused from class to attend this training.—Fr. Mark
