Soens at the Cathedral of the Epiphany in Sioux City as a priest for the Diocese of Sioux City. Both of us acknowledge that these have been twenty-five [25] short/good years. It is a great joy to serve in ordained ministry. Thank you for all your best wishes. Corpus Christi Sunday is June 18. Deacon Greg and I will be leading a Eucharistic Procession after the 10:00 a.m. Mass at St. Bernard. We are in need of volunteers: one [1] more Altar Server to assist with the procession and a few adults to help carry the Eucharistic Canopy [we need six [6] and will have more to assist/trade off during the procession]. For All Parishes:

- **CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION** will begin at the end of the 10:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday June 18, after the final blessing, with Exposition. In place of the usual recessional song, we will begin the procession out of the church with incense, cross, and candles leading Fr. Mark with the monstrance. Once on the front steps of the church the Eucharistic Procession Canopy, carried by six [6] persons, will be held over the monstrance. Everyone is invited to follow the procession as we process around the church property, to the south/west/north/east, and back into church. The procession may take about 10-15 minutes, during which time we will pray a Eucharistic Litany. Once we return to the church the Monstrance will be placed on the altar for a

brief period of Adoration. This will be followed by Benediction and the concluding song. We plan to conclude by 11:30 a.m. Everyone is invited to join us.

- **MINISTRY 2025 UPDATE:** Beginning June 27 Fr. Kevin Richter will become pastor of St. Lawrence and Holy Spirit Parishes in Carroll; St. Elizabeth Seton Parish in Glidden; St. Joseph Parish in Dedham; Sacred Heart Parish in Templeton; St. John the Baptist Parish in Arcadia; St. Bernard Parish in Breda; Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish in Mt. Carmel; Holy Family Parish in Lidderdale; St. Augustine Parish in Halbur, Holy Angels Parish in Roselle, St. Mary Parish in Willey and Annunciation Parish in Coon Rapids and will be assisted by four priests [parochial vicars/associate pastors] Fr. Mark Stoll, Fr. Brian Feller, Fr. John Gerald, and Fr. Shinoj Jose [who will move to the county from Milford]. We will also be assisted by Fr. Timothy Schott, a retired priest currently assisting with Holy Spirit-Carroll and St. Mary-Willey, and seven [7] deacons. I will remain in residence at Breda and continue the usual daily Mass schedule plus preside a Mass at Regency Park Nursing Center in Carroll once a week a few times a month. Deacon Greg will continue to assist in these three parishes. The other four priests will be living in the other four available parish houses/rectories. On weekends, the six priests will be on a rotation schedule and visit each of the six groupings of parishes every six weeks. Stay tuned for more details.
- **BAPTISM CLASS ...** if you are expecting a child or wishing to baptize a child, please contact the pastor to register for baptism class [if this is your first child or if it has been more than five years since the baptism of your previous child]. The date of Baptism is to be arranged with the pastor after completion of a Baptism Class [held quarterly]. The next Baptism Class is Wednesday June 21, 7:00 p.m. in the Family Ministry Room at St. Bernard-Breda.
- **PERSONS WISHING TO JOIN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH,** whether baptized in another faith or unbaptized and over the age of seven [7], may contact the pastor at any time of the year to begin the process known as RCIA [Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults]/RCIC [Rite of Christian Initiation of Children].
- **GRAIN DONATIONS** are accepted by the parish IF the farmer transfers ownership of the grain to the parish using the proper Grain Transfer Form found on the parish website. Then the grain cooperative is to contact the parish office to notify the staff that the parish is now owners of the grain. It is then the responsibility of the parish staff to sell the grain at its discretion. We are grateful for any and all donations which are made to the parish for the mission of the parish. The most convenient donations are made via cash donations [cash or check] from the donors' bank account. The custom where by farmers take a load of grain to their local cooperative and ask the cooperative to write a check out to the parish is illegal according to IRS rules and thus the parish has the right and will refuse to accept grain checks using this procedure. If you have any questions, please contact your parish office. Thank you.
- **CATHOLICISM: THE PIVOTAL PLAYERS** will help us discover the figures who shaped the Church and changed the world. - **CEMETERY IMPROVEMENT PLANS** have been in the works for over a year. The plan has been approved by the Parish Council and now by Bishop Nickless so we may proceed. The first stage of the plan has been completed—to remove the row of trees on the north side of the cemetery and trim the center row of trees. The second stage will begin later this spring or early summer with the installation of an eight [8] foot tall fiber glass fence made by F&F Composite Group, Inc. in Keller, Texas. This work is being made possible by a generous donation of over \$30,000.00 to help beautify the cemetery. A sample of the fence is available for viewing in the back of church.
