For All Parishes:

- CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION** will begin at the end of the 10:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday June 18, after the final blessing, with Exposition. In place of the usual recessional song, we will begin the procession out of the church with incense, cross, and candles leading Fr. Mark with the monstrance. Once on the front steps of the church the Eucharistic Procession Canopy, carried by six [6] persons, will be held over the monstrance. Everyone is invited to follow the procession as we process around the church property, to the south/west/north/east, and back into church. The procession may take about 10-15 minutes, during which time we will pray a Eucharistic Litany. Once we return to the church the Monstrance will be placed on the altar for a brief period of Adoration. This will be followed by Benediction and the concluding song. We plan to conclude by 11:30 a.m. Everyone is invited to join us.

- **MINISTRY 2025 UPDATE:** The new team of priests for Carroll County is set to arrive on June 27th. We have met a few times to begin to plan our ministry to the parishes of the county. We want to make sure that we are available to the people of each of the parishes, so the priests will be living at each of the sites where Pastors are currently living:
 - Fr. Kevin Richter @ Holy Spirit, Carroll (with Willey)
 - Fr. Brian Feller @ St. Lawrence, Carroll (with Lidderdale)
 - Fr. Mark Stoll @ Breda (with Mt. Carmel and Arcadia)
 - Fr. Shinoj Jose @ Halbur (with Roselle and Templeton)
 - Fr. John Gerald @ Coon Rapids (with Dedham and Glidden)

In general, each priest will oversee that parish or cluster of parishes where they reside. Fr. Kevin Richter, as Pastor, will have a rotation of office hours through each of the parishes/clusters. Information about that rotation will be provided in the bulletin in a few weeks.

For this first year, each parish can expect to have the same weekend schedule of Masses as they currently have (with a few minor changes). These five priests, with the addition of Fr. Tim Schott, will rotate through all of the parishes for the weekend Masses. For daily Masses, the priests will largely stay in the parish/cluster where they reside. The schedule for daily Masses will have some changes - please watch the bulletin each week for the daily Mass schedule.

- **BAPTISM CLASS ...** if you are expecting a child or wishing to baptize a child, please contact the pastor to register for baptism class [if this is your first child or if it has been more than five years since the baptism of your previous child]. The date of Baptism is to be arranged with the pastor after completion of a Baptism Class [held quarterly]. The next Baptism Class is Wednesday June 21, 7:00 p.m. in the Family Ministry Room at St. Bernard-Breda.
- **PERSONS WISHING TO JOIN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH**, whether baptized in another faith or unbaptized and over the age of seven [7], may contact the pastor at any time of the year to begin the process known as RCIA [Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults]/RCIC [Rite of Christian Initiation of Children].
