FROM THE DESK OF THE Regional PAROCHIAL VICAR: On this Passion Sunday I am here. Thank you everyone who joined us last Wednesday for the showing of Therese and for attending the Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit.

The Eucharist is very connected to agriculture. One way is with the production of palms. The wet winter in Texas has reduced the yield of palms. Thus, we only received half of our normal order.

Holy Week begins today. Weather permitting, we will begin each Mass outside with the blessing of palms and process back into church. Each liturgy/Mass of Holy Week requires extra ministers. Information is being sent to Readers and Altar Servers to help them prepare for each solemn liturgy. The EASTER VIGIL is a major and significant liturgical celebration for our Church. Most everyone ought to be present for this liturgy. As with last year, we will be using the services of ministers from the three parishes of CTKCC. We are in need of one [1] more Altar Server for the Easter Vigil. If you are able to assist, please contact me. This Easter Vigil will be extra special as we baptize the Elect of God, Dani Mueggenberg, and receive into the Church the Candidate, Stephanie Neumayer, and Confirm and First Communicate both to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church. The Lenten Fast continues until Holy Saturday as the Paschal Fast. During these three holiest days of the year, the TRIDUUM, we are to cease normal activities to pray, fast, and to attend the liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday [Easter Vigil].
