**FROM THE DESK OF THE Regional PAROCHIAL VICAR:** On Fifth Sunday of Easter Fr. Tim Schott, our future sacramental minister, is here and I am at Lidderdale and Willey. Quarterly, or so, representatives, including the Lay Directors, meet as a Parish Council in each parish to review the financial status of each respective parish and discuss parish matters. At each parish's recent meetings discussion was held about hiring a full-time administrative assistant to work at St. Bernard-Breda to be in place by July 10 and to be funded by the six [6] parishes will be pastoring to assist in my work. This job opening will be offered after consulting with representatives of the other 3 parishes. Again, on July 10 I become the pastor of the parishes in Breda, Mount Carmel, Arcadia, Halbur/Roselle, Templeton, and Glidden. I will remain in residence in Breda and the office in Breda will become the center/hub of the expanded Christ the King Catholic Community.
