For All Parishes:

- **SUNDAY MASS TIMES** beginning July 14-15 have been set after a April 26th meeting with Lay Directors and bookkeepers [of Breda, Mount Carmel, Arcadia, Halbur, Roselle, Templeton, and Glidden], Deacon Greg, and Frs. Schott and Stoll; and after much thought, prayer, and conversations have created to be what we believe is the most workable schedule:
 - a. **Saturday 5:00 p.m.-Templeton**
 - b. **Saturday 5:30 p.m.-Glidden**
 - c. **Sunday 8:00 a.m.-Mount Carmel**
 - d. **Sunday 8:00 a.m.-Halbur**
 - e. **Sunday 10:00 a.m.-Breda**
 - f. **Sunday 10:00 a.m.-Arcadia**

This will allow for travel time for the priests and Deacon Greg and Reconciliation one half hour before each Mass. Fr. Schott will typically preside at Masses at Glidden, Mount Carmel, and Breda and Fr. Mark at Templeton, Halbur, and Arcadia. However, on the first Sunday of the month the priests will switch. Thus, parishioners will see each priest for about three [3] weekends in a row and then the other one of us. Deacon Greg typically assists at one Mass per weekend and preaches at all the Masses on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Deacon Greg will follow my presiding schedule and will assist me, unless Fr. Schott has request or need of his assistance. The weekday Mass schedule will be announced later.

- **MISSION COOPERATIVE** is the program the Diocese of Sioux City participates with the Society of the Propagation of the Faith to bring missionaries from the around the world to our parishes each year to share their stories and to ask for assistance. Next weekend June 16-17, Fr. Francis Ejero Ekere will visit our parishes to speak about the Diocese of Minna in Nigeria, still considered a mission territory with a minority Catholic population in a thickly Muslim population in North Central Nigeria. The Diocese of Minna, population around 95,000 and growing, while sharing their poverty and meagre resources, relies on donations to keep some of her educational and rural health programs open to the poor, as it ministers to mostly peasant farmers, petty traders and students. Given the challenges of poverty and being in the midst of a Muslim population that is not always tolerant, the Diocese, is committed to responding to the issues of social justice, health care and human development. This is a great opportunity to share in the missionary work of the Catholic Church by standing in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need. The Diocese of Minna depends on your kind generosity to effectively provide and sustain primary health care programs, like immunization, clinics for the treatment of minor diseases, pre-natal and post-natal care for pregnant mothers in poor and remote areas of the diocese, building of schools in rural communities, digging cisterns for cleaner and better sanitary conditions, and for support the building of churches in rural communities for the dignity of the Eucharist. Minna Diocese appreciates whatever support you are able to give at this time. A second collection will be taken after Holy Communion next weekend for the Propagation of the Faith and the Diocese of Minna.
