FROM THE PASTOR...With the other priests in Carroll County, I take turns presiding at school Masses at Kuemper. When I am at that Mass, the daily Mass will be cancelled in the parish and Deacon Greg will be present to lead Morning Prayer. Please join him this Wednesday in Mount Carmel.

The Diocese of Sioux City is comprised of four [4] deaneries [areas] under the supervision of a priest appointed by the bishop to serve as Dean. During the school year the priests and deacons of each deanery gather for prayer, meeting, and meal. The SE Deanery is comprised of the counties of Crawford, Carroll, Green, Boone, Sac, Calhoun, and Buena Vista. Our first meeting is this Tuesday.

As Dean of the SE Deanery [reason for the "Very Rev." and "VF"] I serve on the Presbyteral Council—the priest advisory board for Bishop Nickless. I will be at this meeting on Thursday.

The 2018/2019 Diocesan Annual Appeal (DAA) kick-off begins this weekend. This is our opportunity to assist the Diocese in its ministry work. We can assist our parish as well for when our parish goes over its diocesan support goal, 100% of that overage amount is returned to parish for its use. Last year over \$554,408 was given back to parishes across the Diocese, some of that to Arcadia, Breda, Halbur, and Roselle. Let's make it a goal for all six parishes of Christ the King Catholic Community to reach our goals.

WEDDINGS Time: The latest a wedding with a Mass can begin on Saturday is at 2:00 p.m. or without a Mass at 2:30 p.m. on a Saturday in accord with Diocesan policy. A Friday evening and a Sunday wedding is also an option. There are some days, including Holy Days and the Triduum that weddings are not permitted. Please check with the pastor regarding these days. Considerations are to be made for the liturgical season of the Church year so that the celebration (including decorations) takes into consideration the spirit of the season (i.e. Lent weddings call for very simple and more solemn atmosphere). Church expense: There is no charge for the use of the church building for parishioners. \$300 is charged to non-parishioners [grooms and/or brides who have no connection to the parish through previous sacramental celebrations (i.e. baptism) or parents who were or are currently members].
