Signs of this include the declining size of the family, closing/consolidating our Catholic schools as well as our public schools, declining number of priests, the closing of parishes beginning in the 1990s, lack of faith formation for adults, declining number of people celebrating the Sacraments [Baptism, Reconciliation, Matrimony], and many more.... These are signs to us that we need to do something different. The Ministry 2025 process is about setting goals for each parish to revitalize the parish, to increase parish involvement, to increase attendance at Mass, to help our priests to serve, and to re-energize our Diocese. What can we do to do this?
