BISHOP NICKLESS AND BISHOPS NATIONWIDE are joining in seven days of prayer and fasting [Monday, November 5, through Sunday, November 11] prior to their General Assembly meeting in November, where they will make critical decisions regarding the tragedy of clergy abuse. A letter with more details from Bishop Nickless is available on the Diocese of Sioux City website at www.scdioocese.org and in the November 1st edition of The Catholic Globe. The intentions for this period of prayer and fasting are three-fold: • For the healing and support of all victims of clergy sexual abuse. • For the conversion and just punishment of the perpetrators and concealers of sexual abuse. • For the strength of the bishops to be holy shepherds in protecting and leading their sheep from all harm.
