When various crises arise in the Church, we seek to address them, to make amends, to seek forgiveness and reconciliation, and to correct what needs fixing. Since 2003 the Diocese of Sioux City, along with the many diocese in the United States, introduced the Safe Environment Program [SEP]. Since then, all priests, deacons, religious, employees, teachers, catechists, lay directors, and volunteers [especially those working regularly with children] in our parishes, schools, hospitals, and nursing homes are required to complete a background check before being employed and take part in a SEP class known as Virtus. This program is another way that we are doing what we can to provide a safe environment for our children and vulnerable persons in our diocesan entities. I and a few staff members continue to monitor all persons who are in these six [6] parishes to ensure that our staff and volunteers remain current in their training and practices.
