I encourage everyone to participate in the liturgies of the TRIDUUM: Holy Thursday Mass [celebrating the Last Supper with the institution of the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Holy Orders], Good Friday Service [celebrating the death of Jesus], and the Easter Vigil [celebrating the resurrection of Jesus]. The Easter Vigil must begin after dark, that is why we are beginning at 9:00 p.m., as it will not be dark until close to 9:00 p.m. this year. For the last 15 years I have always began at 9:00 p.m. as it is always dark by then, no matter when Holy Saturday falls each year.
