Present: Father Mark Stoll, Donna Wesely, Brian Hoffman, Dean Pudenz, Scott Wiederin, Ann Schmitz and Annette Haberl

Ann Schmitz opened the meeting with a prayer.

Minutes from the August 28, 2018 meeting were reviewed and approved. Motion was made by Brian Hoffman, 2nd by Scott Wiederin, all were in favor and the motion for approval of the August Minutes passed.

Balance and Profit and loss reports were reviewed. Kuemper payment as of July 2018 will be \$131,258.53, an increase of approximately \$10,000 from previous year. Brian Hoffman made a motion to approve those reports and 2nd by Scott Wiederin. All were in favor.

Garbage service by Carroll Refuse had been a free service until a different company purchased it. Cost is now \$39.00 a month. Additional charge if more pick up is required during busy seasons at the hall.

ParishSoft has been functioning well. Parish members may check accounts. It will provide information on the people in each parish.

November Mass count for 2018 was 558; 2017 was 618; 2016 was 478.

150th update-Spaghetti supper was well attended and a success, no figures on profits yet. T-shirt sales are going well. Details on liquor license were discussed. Pending at this time until later date, discussion.

Dean reported the parish hall needs some repairs due to a roof leak, a window leak, and mold by that window.

Regarding paint and mold issues in the church, Brian will contact K&D painting to obtain an estimate of what it would cost to do repairs.

A donation has been offered by Mary Feldman for the repair of stone chapel. Perhaps, Denison Drywall could be contacted to offer a bid. Perhaps, cement board and insulation is needed to do the repairs.

In June, a \$5,000.00 gift from the Irma Grote family was given to parish. It may be used for some for church repair.

Isaac Evans, for an Eagle Scout project, is working on a directory for the cemetery. Lori Loneman is assisting him with this.

The next Finance Council meeting will be held Tuesday, February 19th at Mt. Carmel.

Dean motioned to adjourn. Brian Hoffman seconded the motion. All were in favor. Meeting was adjourned with a prayer by Father Stoll.
