

THE RCIA IN NOVEMBER

Here is the November schedule for the RCIA, the *Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*. The sessions take place in the Burke Center on Wednesday nights beginning at 7:00p.m. and last from 60 to 90 minutes, depending on the topic and the presenter.

We now have six participants, the largest group in many years, which will make the Easter Vigil next April all the more important for our community—and also a bit longer! But this schedule is being presented as an invitation to any parishioner who might like to attend on one or more nights to be updated on a topic that interests you. Your presence can also represent the support of the wider parish community for those who are preparing to become new members or complete their initiation with us. The dates, topics and presenters are:

- November 7 - *Illness and the Anointing of the Sick* - Mary Bohlen & Fr. Bob
- November 14 - *The Old Testament: Our Christian Heritage* - Fr. Bob
- November 28 - *The Gospels and the New Testament* - Fr. Dan

Again, anyone is welcome to attend, but it would be helpful if you would call the rectory a day or two in advance to let us know you'll be coming so that the presenter can make enough copies of any handouts. Both the front and side doors of the Burke Center will be open, so you can park in either the rear parking lot or the main lot.
