

MINISTERIAL REVIEW - CATHOLIC LEADERSHIP 360

As you saw in last week's bulletin, I'm participating in a new periodic review process the Archdiocese has instituted for all priests in active ministry. One portion of that was my selection of a limited number of parish leaders and parish members to complete a more extensive online review. The other portion, as Bishop Perry explained in his letter, give anyone who wishes an opportunity to participate in this process.

The parish-wide survey can be accessed by going to the Archdiocese of Chicago website (www.archchicago.org) and clicking on *Offices and Ministries*, located in the top panel. This will bring you to an alphabetical listing of offices; scroll down to "M" and select *Ministerial Evaluation*. You will then be directed to the Ministerial Evaluation web page. In the middle of the page, you will find *360 Leadership Review for Priests*. Click on the word "link" next to the appropriate language to access the survey. Good luck with that; unfortunately the Archdiocesan website has been somewhat notorious in the past few years for not keeping the site up to date, and personally, I find it extraordinarily difficult to navigate.

If you feel more comfortable doing this the perfectly good old-fashioned way with pen and paper, copies of the parish-wide evaluation will be on the tables in the rear of church through February 17; all forms must be returned by February 20th, and you would need to mail in the paper forms. Whether online or on paper, everything is confidential, and I am only given access to a summary report, not the individual reviews.
