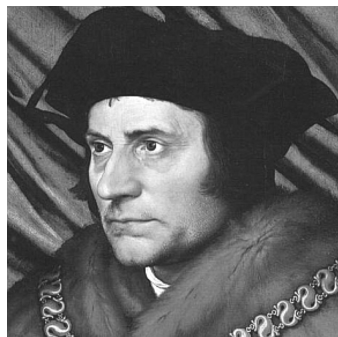

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the first reading, taken from the First Book of Kings, we hear about the prophet Elijah raising from the dead the son of a widow. In addition to her overwhelming joy, the widow learned two important lessons in the miracle of her resuscitated son. First, her son's death was not divine retribution for the sins she committed in her life—a belief and a fear held by some ancient Israelites. And second, the prophet Elijah was truly a “man of God.”

Scholars have often noted the similarities between the story of Elijah raising the widow's son and today's Gospel reading — Jesus' raising of the widow's son from the village of Nain. Beyond the obvious parallels in these miracle stories, the reaction of those witnessing the miracle is very similar as well: “A great prophet has arisen in our midst” and “God has visited his people.”

The second reading is taken from Paul's Letter to the Galatians and is one of Paul's most emotionally charged letters. He is angry over the news that the Galatian men were having themselves circumcised, a direct violation of the Gospel message he preached to them. In today's reading, as part of his argument, Paul presents himself and his Gospel message as divinely authoritative: “I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel preached by me is not of human origin. For I did not receive it from a human being, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ.”
