Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Discipleship in the Gospel of Luke carries a very clear set of expectations. Among other things, a disciple must keep a proper attitude toward wealth and possessions.

In today's Gospel, as Jesus continues on his journey to Jerusalem, someone from the crowd makes a request of him: "Teacher, tell my brother to share the inheritance with me." Rather than get involved in family matters between siblings and inheritance rights, Jesus offers two responses. Jesus' first immediate response is to give some simple advice, a warning against greed and the desire for material possessions. Jesus' second and more measured response is to tell a parable to the crowd. The parable of the Rich Fool. For Jesus' audience, the rich man would have been judged as foolish and even dishonorable because he chose not to share his surplus wealth with others who would have granted him public praise and earned him an honorable reputation as a generous patron to others within his community. But Jesus discourages this typical reaction by inviting the crowd to go beyond the desire for material possessions and the acquisition of a higher honor; seek instead the spiritual treasure offered by God—eternal life through his Son.
