Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel reading, the third and final section of Luke's Sermon on the Plain, contains a series of parables about how to be a good disciple.

- The blind cannot lead the blind. A disciple cannot be a good disciple unless he or she has learned from the teacher. "No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher."
- Before you can be a good disciple and teach others you must take care of yourself and deal with your own shortcomings. "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?"
- Finally, only when you have integrity and purity of heart can you produce the good works that the teacher requires. "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit."

The final parable, which we do not read today, is about building discipleship on the solid foundation of Christ's teachings, as they are the only way to face the difficulties a disciple will ultimately encounter.
