Third Sunday of Lent

As the season of Lent continues, today's readings are a reminder of the importance of spiritual discernment that properly leads us to ongoing repentance, and an examination of conscience.

In today's Gospel, we hear two separate stories: Jesus' call for repentance and the parable of the barren fig tree. Luke's connection of these traditions offers a good example of his interest in blending history and theology seen throughout Luke-Acts. In the first part of the reading, Jesus recalls two recent events in which people unexpectedly died. He cites the Galileans who were murdered by Pilate and the accidental deaths of those killed in the tower collapse at Siloam as instructive reminders of the need for all to repent and be in right relationship with God. The story of these tragic deaths serves as a good backdrop for interpreting Jesus' parable of the barren fig tree. The parable speaks to the need for believers to "bear fruit" with the faith they have received. Believers bear good fruit by being grounded in repentance and seeking union with God. The parable also addresses God's mercy and forgiveness tempered with the coming end-time. At some point in time, all will be held accountable to God on judgment day for the fruit they bore in this life.
