Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel reading for today is the beginning section of Luke's long travel narrative, (Luke 9:51—19:44). Luke significantly expands Mark's version of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem (Mk 8:21—10:52), incorporating much of his own source material into this section and developing some of his favorite theological themes: discipleship, repentance, mercy, and forgiveness. Luke begins his narration of Jesus' long journey to Jerusalem by commenting that Jesus "resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem." The journey begins with a rough start in a Samaritan village. As Jesus and his disciples continue the journey, would-be followers of Jesus approach him and quickly learn the high price to be paid for discipleship. Following Jesus must be unconditional: "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." (This is in stark contrast to the first reading with Elijah's reaction to Elisha putting his house in order before accepting his call to prophecy). As the travel narrative continues, Jesus will teach his followers that a disciple must also have a proper attitude toward wealth and possessions, be willing to serve others, be humble, and, of course, "carry his own cross."
