Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel reading for the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time concludes with a sobering warning: "Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more." Jesus directs this saying to his disciples, encouraging them to be faithful and prudent stewards to their calling until the second coming of Christ. Today's Gospel is actually three of Jesus' sayings. The first saying is Jesus' invitation to nurture a relationship with God and ends with a pithy wisdom line: "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." The second saying offers a more directed warning to disciples to be ready for the return of Christ: "Be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open the door immediately when he comes and knocks." Since many distractions and challenges of daily life can put a follower's "house" at risk, Jesus implores his disciples to "be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." The stage for the third saying is set by Peter's question to Jesus ("Lord, is this parable meant for us or for everyone?"). Here Jesus speaks to the disciples of "the faithful and prudent steward" whom God "put in charge" of his servants and his property. With this divine charge comes an awesome responsibility that can sometimes be neglected or squandered. In Jesus' concluding remarks to the disciples, we see Luke's perspective on the end-time and the divine judgment that follows: the demands of discipleship cannot be subject to benign neglect or misuse as the faithful await the return of Christ.
