

Do You Need Work Done At Your Home? Catholic Heart Workcamp Can Help! Catholic Heart Workcamp, a week-long service camp for teenagers, will be coming to Saranac Lake this summer and is seeking homes in the Saranac Lake area (within 45 miles of Saranac Lake) at which a small group of teenagers and adults can work. Groups will be available to work on June 24-27, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Typical projects include: painting homes (both interior and exterior) and garages; cleaning homes (inside and outside); washing windows; doing yardwork such as planting, weeding, raking and clearing brush; staining/painting porches, decks and wheelchair ramps, and cleaning out garages and basements.
