Meditations on Holy Mass

Twenty-Third Sunday in O.T. (Year C)

First reading: Wisdom 9.13-18

Who can discern what the Lord wills?

Second reading: Philemon 9b-10, 12-17

Take him back, no longer as a slave but as a much beloved brother.

Gospel: Luke 14.25-33 CCC 470; 692; 729

Whoever of you does not give up all that he has cannot be my disciple.

In the *first reading*, the sacred author announces that earthly considerations must yield to God's wisdom. To follow Christ, we must confidently place ourselves in his service with humility. This anticipates *the Gospel*, in which St. Luke reminds us that a spirit of detachment is essential to following Christ. The *second reading* teaches that our personal relationships, even among family members, must also be at the service of Christ.

Before Mass: Anyone who does not carry his cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. (*Lauds*)

After Mass: None of you can be my disciple unless he gives up all his possessions. (*Vespers*)
