**STRESS IN YOUR MARRIAGE!**



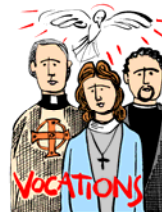

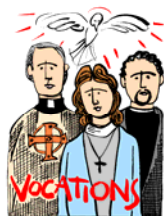
