## Quo Vadis Vocation Discernment Group 2018-2019 Schedule

*Quo Vadis* is Latin for “where are you going?” Tradition states that St. Peter asked Jesus this question as Peter was fleeing Rome due to the persecutions. St. Peter was cut to the heart by Christ’s response and returned to Rome to accept martyrdom.

Is Jesus calling me to be a Catholic priest? It’s not an easy question to answer. It takes prayer and study to discover your true vocation. Quo Vadis is a discernment group of men like you who love Jesus Christ and His Church, and who are willing to talk with other like-minded men about their future.

The group meetings aren’t meant to convince you that priesthood is your vocation. You could very well be called to marriage or to another vocation. But if you’re a faithful Catholic man between the ages of 18 and 35 – even if you’re currently dating – at some point you have to ask yourself whether God is calling you to be a priest.
