Faith Formation and Sacramental Preparation: Call the Office or visit our website for dates and other information about any of the following:

If you or a loved one would like to receive the **Anointing of the Sick**, or if you are Homebound and would like **Communion** brought to you, or if any Homebound person would like Father to hear their **Confession**, please call the office.

Infant Baptism Class: Classes are offered for parents of children under the age of 7. Godparents must be confirmed, active members of the Church, and should attend the class along with the parents. Next Baptism class will be **May 19 at 1:00 p.m.** Please pre-register by contacting the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples should contact the Priest at least six months before the wedding to prepare.

Kids/Teen Formation: K-12 grade classes are held on Sundays **after the 10:30 Mass** in the Parish Hall. Registration is ongoing. These classes are for ALL children and teens, whether preparing for a Sacrament or not!

Adult Formation: Everyone is invited to join us each **Monday at 5:30 PM** in the Parish Hall. These gatherings are for anyone who wants to learn more about Jesus and the Church.

Pastor's Note: Anyone desiring to prepare to receive any Sacrament should make a resolution to live the Faith by:

- 1. Consistent Mass attendance on Sundays & Holy Days;**
- 2. Regular Confession;**
- 3. Daily Prayer.**

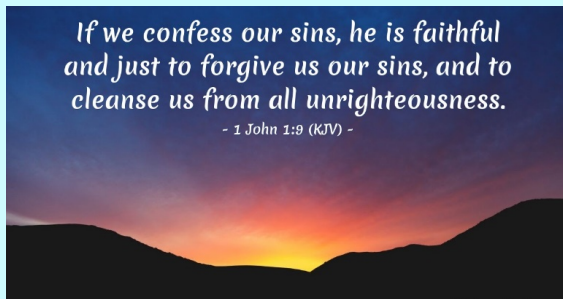


“Peter, do you love me?”

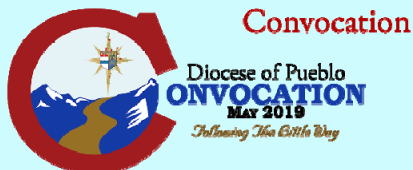
In today’s Gospel, John 21:1-19, Jesus asks Peter three times if he loves Him. In Scripture, numbers are used to make a point and express a deeper meaning. Three is very significant. For example, Jonah remained in the belly of the whale for three days before he was saved by God. Saul, who later became Paul, regained his sight on the third day. Jesus was raised from the dead on the third day. And just before the crucifixion, Peter denied knowing Jesus three times.

When the Risen Lord appears to his disciples, he brings forgiveness, not retribution. He offers “Peace” to those who deserted Him just days before. He gives Peter a three-fold opportunity for forgiveness. Peter was distressed when asked the third time, undoubtedly uncomfortable with the reminder of his three denials. In John’s account of Peter’s denial, John 18:15-27, a charcoal fire is mentioned. A charcoal fire is also present in the scene at the shore; another reminder to Peter of his past disloyalty to Jesus. Despite his denial, Peter is reconciled to Jesus through Jesus’ forgiveness of sins. Peter is restored.

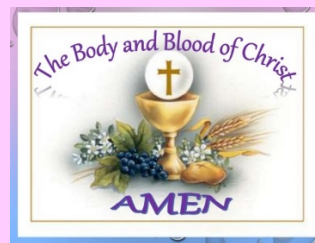
IMPORTANT UPCOMING DATES
