

LOVE AND THE CROSS IN THE LIFE OF FR.

ALBERTO CUSCO MIR, S.J.

A tree is known for its fruits, it is a popular saying. . . . We want to present to you, two tasty fruits being helped to grow and ripen by our Father Founder Alberto Cusco Mir in his hard experience of life. We know that he lived *alone*, the great part of his religious life, for he was persecuted for his own religious brothers in the Society of Jesus. . . He was brilliant in his first years, when he had the possibility of preaching in churches and temples with hundreds of listeners. They felt attracted to his words full of the fire and fervor for the love he had for Jesus Christ and Mary, His Mother.

Then God Almighty called Fr. Alberto to be the founder of a great apostolic work, the Apostolate of the Cross and later to a religious Congregation dedicated to love and console the inner pains and sufferings of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. But then, God permitted that Fr. Alberto would be sent away from his Jesuit brothers, sent away from the foundations he had started. He also received the warning of being expelled from the Society of Jesus, whom he deeply loved. He was sent to live alone, abandoned and rejected by his Jesuit brothers. He had to carry the Cross of his Christ, his heart heavy with sorrow, like that of Our Lord. No one saw Fr. Alberto alive for a long time. He died one day before his 64th birthday. Through the intercession of the Blessed Mother, he was not expelled from the Society of Jesus.

Nevertheless, there were two persons who were close to Fr. Alberto Mir and lived his doctrine, and through it, gave glory to God. These two souls walked on the path of sanctity under his teachings and his example of life. One was Sister Maria Angelica Alvarez Icaza of the religious order of the Visitation of Mary. Her cause of canonization is well advanced. The other is our Foundress, Mother Julia Navarrete Guerrero; Fr. Alberto was her spiritual director. Her cause for canonization is well-known. Mother Julia's spirituality was similar to that of St. Therese of Jesus. Both Mother Julia and Sister Maria would point out how Fr. Mir would lead them on the path to holiness. Mother Julia said Fr. Alberto Mir was a contemplative or mystic. "He was in continuous prayer. He was living in the world but his spirit was in God. Often we would see him intensely recollected and talking to God. Sometimes we would see him standing in front of the Crucified Lord that was in the room where he received the sisters as if he was talking to Jesus. Fr. Alberto's face would become red with fervor and ardent love for our Lord. When he celebrated Mass, everyone could see his profound love and recollection for the Eucharist and how it transformed him.
