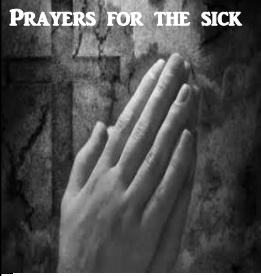

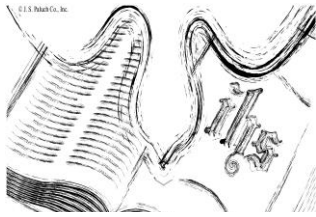

DOGMAS ON MARY IMMACULATE, THE MOTHER OF GOD

What is a Dogma? The Catholic Church considers a dogma, a truth revealed by God and defined by the Church, which we Catholics must accept in faith and obedience to the Church’s authority.

In regard to Mary, the Mother of God, the dogmas of faith, defined by the Church, through the years, are four:

1. THE DIVINE MATERNITY OF MARY. This dogma was defined in the Council of Ephesus, celebrated the 22nd of June, 431, under the Pontificate of Pope Celestino. In Jesus Christ there are two natures, the divine and the human, but in one Person. The Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, The Son, is God, as the Father and the Holy Spirit. We honor Mary, the Mother of God, in a solemn Mass every year, on January first.
2. THE PERPETUAL VIRGINITY OF MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD. This dogma was defined in the Council of Lateran, celebrated in 649, under the Pontificate of Pope St. Martin I.

We know nothing is impossible to God: When the Archangel Gabriel announced to Mary that she was chosen by God to be the Mother of the Messiah, she asked the Archangel how that could be if she was a virgin? The Archangel answer her: “The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you, and the Child that will be born from you will be holy, He will be called son of God.” Mary replied: “Behold the hand maid of the Lord, let it be done, according to your word.” The Fathers of the Council, inspired by the Holy Spirit composed the Third Canon that declares this dogma.

Since the beginning of the Church, the Holy Fathers pronounced themselves in such an admirable privilege. We will mention some of them and what they said: St. Efrén and St. Basilio, were the first ones in naming Mary with the title of “Virgin always, pure, always immaculate,” Virgin preserved by grace of all stain of sin”, St. Ambrose. “She is called immaculate, because she did not suffer any corruption,” St. Jerome.

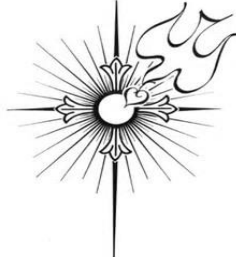
It was necessary that the Mother of God be most pure, without stain, without sin. It was not convenient that the sanctuary of God, the house of wisdom, the shrine of the Holy Spirit would have in it the smallest stain of sin. As it is written, “She fixed her place in the peace” (Sal75,3) in other words the mansion of the divine wisdom was constructed totally free from sin. (Santo Toms de Villanueva)

In the next Bulletin you will find the other two dogmas on Mary: Immaculate Conception and Assumption of Mary in body and soul to Heaven.
