The third Saturday procession from the Cathedral didn't process to the mill due to stormy weather.

On the last Saturday in August a new abortionist arrived to abort the little ones. She is a young woman with long blonde hair.

Shortly after this abortionist arrived a woman came who was not able to walk up the stairs by her self. She had to have the driver and an escort help her up the steps. Did this "new" abortionist injure her in a botched abortion? We will be looking into this matter in coming days.

Trump Defunds Planned Parenthood, Abortion Biz Loses \$60 Million in Taxpayer Dollars

The Planned Parenthood abortion business announced today it will officially withdraw from the Title X program — costing it \$60 million in taxpayer funds because it refuses to follow a new Trump administration rule that requires it to segment out its abortion business from legitimate health care if it wants federal funding under the program.

Because the abortion giant is withdrawing from Title X, the \$60 million in taxpayer dollars it received annually can be redistributed to groups that engage in legitimate women's health care.

The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals late Friday rejected a request from more than 20 states, Planned Parenthood and the American Medical Association to block new pro-life rules that Planned Parenthood is refusing to follow. Leading pro-life groups have praised the Trump administration for prioritizing women's health ahead of abortion. This action adds to President Trump's record of defunding the Planned Parenthood abortion company.

Title X funds are supposed to be used to help low-income women and men receive birth control, cancer screenings and other health care services. While the tax money cannot be used to pay for abortions, it indirectly funds Planned Parenthood's vast abortion business.

Planned Parenthood Director Fired for Exposing How Its Abortions Hurt Women Wins \$3 Million

An Arizona court on Friday awarded \$3 million to a former Planned Parenthood director of 17 years after she sued them for wrongful termination. The abortion giant fired Mayra Rodriguez after she exposed how the abortions Planned Parenthood does hurt women.

In a stunning victory for a former Planned Parenthood director in Arizona who was wrongfully terminated after reporting high complication rates for one abortionist. Rodriguez also exposed the abortionist's illegal conduct falsification of affidavits and patient records, incomplete abortions, and failure to report a minor who had an adult partner and was a victim of statutory rape.

A jury unanimously awarded Mayra Rodriguez \$3 million in damages this past Friday after a two-week trial.

Mayra Rodriguez, who ran three Planned Parenthood clinics in Arizona and worked for the organization for 17 years, sued the non-profit after being wrongfully terminated from her position in October 2017 after repeatedly making claims that Planned Parenthood was endangering the health and safety of their patients.

40 Babies Born Alive After Botched Abortions in Just Three States in Three Years

Their survivals have been called "imaginary" and protections for them unnecessary, but new state health data indicates that at least 40 babies were born alive after botched abortions between 2016 and 2018.

Fox News reports the 40 known abortion survivors were documented in just three states, meaning their likely are many more. Meanwhile, pro-abortion Democrats in Congress have

been blocking legislation to protect these babies' lives.

According to the new research, 11 babies were born alive after botched abortions in Minnesota, 10 in Arizona and 19 in Florida since 2016.

Minnesota has been keeping track of abortion survivors since 2015 when pro-lifers passed the state Born Alive Infants Protection Act. The law recognizes infants who survive abortions as human persons and requires that they be provided with reasonable medical care.

Since the law went into effect, state reports indicate that 11 babies have survived abortions: five in 2016, three in 2017 and three in 2018, according to Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life.

In 2018, one of the three babies had an APGAR score of one, meaning the baby was observed as one of the following: flexed arms or legs, had a pulse (below 100 bpm), had a pink body with bluish hands/feet, displayed some level of breathing or showed facial movements such as a grimace or weak cry, according to the state report.

Missouri Right to Life Celebrates Decision by Judge to Dismiss Planned Parenthood Case

On Tuesday, August 13th Judge Brian Wimes dismissed without prejudice a long court battle against our Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Director Randall Williams.

This long battle concerns whether the Department of Health and Senior Services has the right to have abortion clinics certified as ambulatory surgical centers and have the same standard of health care as other medical facilities and whether physicians performing abortions would have hospital privileges within 30 miles of abortion clinics.

These regulations were and still are common sense medical safety standards. Annual inspections since this lawsuit have shown that oversight over Missouri abortion clinics are needed for the protection and safety of Missouri women and their unborn children.

Keep praying for "right to life" to prevail. There are still many court cases to fight to protect Missouri women and their unborn children!

"Christian" Pastors Bless Abortion Clinic, Singing "Hallelujah. Bless This Room"

How can a person "bless" the violent destruction of a baby's life? Though hard to imagine, it does happen, and some religious leaders do it in the name of Christianity and Judaism.

Earlier this summer, a group of clergy gathered at the Whole Woman's Health abortion facility in North Austin, Texas, to "bless" its life-destroying work, according to the Texas Observer.

About 20 Christian and Jewish leaders who gathered for the event sang, "Hallelujah. Do not fear. You are loved. Bless this room. Bless this womb," in the waiting room of the abortion facility, the report described.

- Missouri abortion law critics won't seek signatures for vote

The ACLU of Missouri and other abortion supporters announced today that they will not be collecting signatures to attempt to put HB 126 on the ballot for a referendum vote. HB 126, the "Heartbeat" bill (also known as the "Missouri Stands for the Unborn Act"), contains numerous pro-life provisions that protect both the lives of the unborn and the health and safety of mothers.

If referendum proponents had been successful in getting the signatures by the August 28 deadline, that would have indefinitely delayed when the bill would have gone into effect, with further election challenges still to come as well as voters in the November 2020 election determining whether or not it would ever go into effect.

Instead, HB 126 will now become law on August 28, pending the outcome of a lawsuit filed by Planned Parenthood and one of its abortion doctors, which is scheduled to be heard in federal court in Kansas City on August 26.

However, even if the plaintiffs are successful in getting the preliminary injunction they are seeking (which can be appealed to a higher court), Planned Parenthood's lawsuit is only attacking portions of the bill, specifically, the regulation of abortion at eight, 14, 18 and 20 weeks of gestation, as well as the restriction on abortions because of the race or sex of the unborn child or because the unborn child may have Down syndrome.

The other provisions in HB 126 will still go into effect on August 28, including:

1. Enhanced pregnancy resource center tax credits, to increase from 50% to 70% with "no limit imposed on the cumulative amount of tax credits that may be claimed by all taxpayers contributing to pregnancy resource centers," beginning on January 1, 2021;
2. Recognition by the Missouri General Assembly that "Almighty God is the author of life," and a declaration that Missouri and all of its political subdivisions are a "sanctuary of life" that protects pregnant women and their unborn children;
3. The "Right to Life of the Unborn Child Act", which would protect unborn children from abortion from conception onward (except in the case of a medical emergency), which would go into effect when *Roe v. Wade* is overruled, a federal Human Life Amendment has been adopted or Congress has enacted a law authorizing Missouri to regulate abortion in this manner ("trigger law");
4. Numerous legislative findings, including: when individual human life begins; the existence of a heartbeat and brainwaves in an unborn child early in development; other markers of human development at various stages of gestation; the capacity for an unborn child to experience pain; the brutality of abortion procedures and the harm caused to women; the rights and obligations of the state to protect both mother and unborn child; and various interests that Missouri has in regulating abortion practice;
5. Modified informed consent provisions specifying that a woman considering abortion be given detailed "information on the possibility of an abortion causing pain in the unborn child," along with a new obligation imposed on abortion facilities and family planning agencies that refer women out of state for abortions to provide all of the same informed consent information to these women as those who are considering abortion in-state; and
6. Increased medical malpractice insurance required of all who perform or induce abortions, and new, additional obligations on those who induce abortions with drugs or chemical to have "tail" insurance for 21 years to cover a child surviving the abortion who is born with a birth defect, disability or other injury.

One provision with an emergency clause already went into effect on May 24, when Gov. Mike Parson signed the bill: a requirement that a second custodial parent be notified in most cases when a minor girl is considering an abortion, in addition to the current law requiring the first custodial parent to give consent.

Margaret Sanger Planned Parenthood Calls Ambulance for Eighth Patient this Year

For the eighth time in 2019, an ambulance has rolled up to the Margaret Sanger Planned Parenthood abortion facility on Bleecker Street in New York City to transport a Planned Parenthood patient to the hospital.

The incident took place on August 1, 2019, at approximately 11:45 a.m. In the past few months, two ambulances have responded to calls for emergency assistance, but this day, only one ambulance from the New York Fire Department responded.

About ten minutes after the ambulance crew entered the Planned Parenthood abortion facility, they emerged with a young Black woman in the seated position on a gurney. She was loaded into the ambulance and transported presumably to a nearby hospital.
