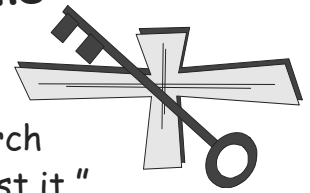
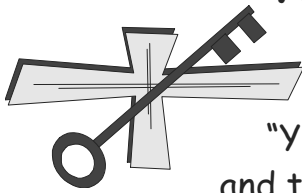

## STAMPING

I understand that "stamping" has been discussed among parish families with children of schoolage. When I was growing up in the 1950s and 1960s, there was no such thing as stamping the bulletin to prove you went to Mass. Mass was just as much a part of Catholic life as visiting grandma, going to school, being home for dinner. My mother and father would ask us kids on the ride home what struck us about Mass that day. It was the leadership of my parents that built a firm foundation of Faith, not stamping.

My mom and dad were not only faithful to Mass. My dad was an usher, my mom cared for the altar server outfits. My brothers and I were altar servers (in Latin). We belonged to CYO. Visitors to our home knew we were Catholic by what they saw and heard in our home. The parish priests were invited to stop by. Religion homework was taken even more seriously than other school subjects.

Is your family too busy for Mass on Sunday? A lot of folks say that. If this is the case, stop it, plain and simple. Give time to Mass. The Catholic standard is that nothing is more important than Mass, not shopping, not sports, not travel, not vacation. The only legitimate excuse is illness or a bad storm.

Can our Catholic families in Holy Rosary embody the standards of Catholicism? There can be no other answer than Yes! The leadership of dad and mom is the best way for children to have a firm foundation in the Catholic Faith.
