SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Behold the Lamb of God," John the Baptist said and two of His Disciples left to follow Jesus. Jesus then asked one of his probing questions: "What are you looking for?" As often happens in John's Gospel, the question does not get a direct answer. Their reply indicated they needed time with him: "Teacher, where are you staying?" Jesus' response was as open then as it is now: "Come and you will see." They stayed the day, and perhaps the night. Whatever was said, it was enough for Andrew to get his brother Simon the next day and take him to Jesus, who immediately changed his name. Encountering and spending time with Jesus usually brings change. At every Mass we hear "Behold, the Lamb of God" before receiving Communion. We can hear it as an invitation to stay with Him, to listen for how He might speak to us, how He might name us: "Beloved," "Brother/Sister," "Friend," "Disciple." Psalm 95 advises: "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." Rather, follow the advice Eli gave Samuel and say, "Speak, for your servant is listening." Are you willing to hear the Lord's voice? To tell him what you are looking for?

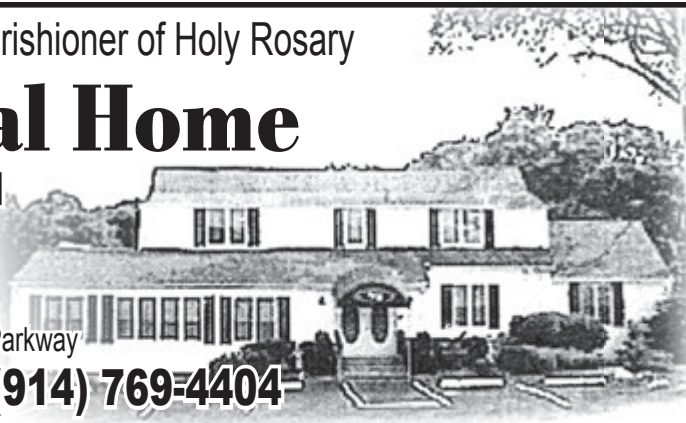
