

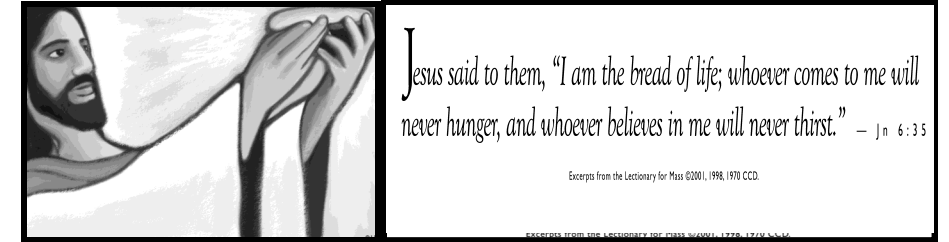

Recently, we renewed our subscription to Formed.org. It is a Catholic resource that is similar to Netflix where Catholic educational and entertainment in the form of podcasts, videos, audiobooks and programs can be downloaded and watched on any device of your choosing, i.e., smart phone, tablet, or smart T.V.

If you have not had the opportunity, please go online to **www.formed.org** and provide our Parish Code: **HWNN8P** and then create your own personal login and password and enjoy the **FREE Catholic resources** at your fingertips. The only cost is a couple minutes of your time to set up an account.

The reason why I am encouraging Formed.org is because as part of the Archbishop's Pastoral Priorities on Catechesis and Faith Formation, this Catholic sponsored service is an easy way to access informative Catholic teaching and resources in our modern world today.

Furthermore, I have asked the Religious Education program and Catholic School teachers to consider assigning homework assignments that the student along side his/her family to watch through the upcoming school year. It is a great way to supplement the religious education learned in the classroom and reinforced at home.

Finally, Fr. Juan Jose and I will have a section in the weekly bulletin called, "Father's Monthly Picks". He and I will recommend once a month a video or podcast that we believe would be worth listening to so we can all grow in the faith together.

With that said, allow me to begin Fr. Michael's Formed.org Pick of the Month with the following. In anticipation of the great Solemnity of the Assumption on Wednesday, August 15 which is a holy day of obligation, my pick is Catholic Answers: Ready Reasons—Does the Bible Disprove the Assumption? To find this 2-minute video, go to search link and type in quotations "Does the Bible Disprove the Assumption?"

If you want to learn more, I recommend, "The Bible and the Virgin Mary: Journey through Scripture." It is a series of 12 lessons and the 11th lesson is devoted to the Assumption that you can watch for the entire month of August to further your love and devotion to our Blessed Mother. It can be found under the link "Study", then hit the tab "Faith Formation" and look for the series.
